



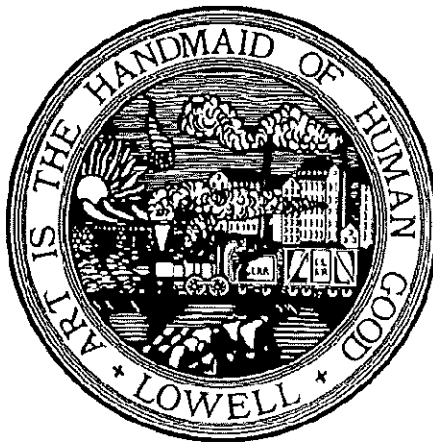

**Discussion: To create an ordinance that would require the City of Lowell ban plastic bags in stores larger than 3,000 square feet. The ordinance would only apply to carryout bags used at stores. These are to be exempt from the ban: thin-film plastic bags used for dry cleaning, newspapers, flexible transparent covering for uncooked raw meat, poultry, raw fish, hard cheese, cold cuts, fruit, vegetable, baked goods or bread and wet items.
