- (d) Violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2): No licensee for the sale of alcoholic beverages shall permit any disorder, disturbance, or illegality of any kind to take place in or on the licensed premises. The licensee shall be responsible therefore, whether present or not.

13. Hearing on the allegation of misconduct as charged by William M. Taylor, Superintendent of Police, against Mill City Ballroom Inc., d/b/a Mill City Ballroom, Joel Asadoorian, Manager, all alcoholic beverages restaurant licensee at 74 Merrimack St. for violation of regulation which took place in front of 74 Merrimack St. on January 1, 2016, to wit: failure to maintain order and decorum in the immediately surrounding area adjacent to the licensed premises, in violation of Section 1.16 of the regulations of the Lowell License Commission.
