Req. City Manager Provide Update Regarding Downtown Spring Cleaning (Including Summer Jobs)

Displayed below is the updated 2018 Street Sweeping Schedule for the entire City. This information is also available on the City Website. The Department of Public Works has begun dispatching the sweepers throughout the City.

The annual plan for the Downtown is for the sweepers to be scheduled for additional patrol in order to supplement the vacuum trucks. We have increased this area to include the Middlesex Street corridor leading to the Judicial Center construction site. Also, the DPW is working with Inspectional Services and Planning & Development to work in collaboration with local businesses and to solicit their assistance. The increased frequency is necessary after the late winter/early spring storms.

Summer Jobs programs are organized through the Lowell Career Center and the City Recreation Department. Depending on their budgets, the Career Center employs approximately 400 and Recreation employs approximately 185 as part of the summer program. Inquiries about the program and the application process can be directed to either of those departments.
