You can help:

Put medications away

- Place medications in a locked drawer, pouch, cabinet, or safe
- Keep count of the pills in each bottle
- Ask the parents of your child's friends to safeguard their medications as well

Dispose of medications

- Bring to the City of Lowell Police Department Drop-off Kiosk (no questions asked)
- Dispose of medications at the next City of Lowell Unwanted Medication and Sharps Disposal Day

Go one step further

- Talk with your doctor about alternative pain management options
- Ask your pharmacist about the Partial-Fill Law which allows you to request a lower opioid prescription count
