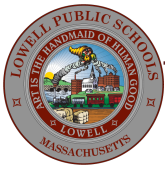

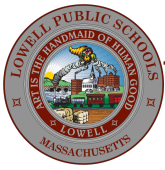


4. EXECUTIVE SESSION
