PAWTUCKET STREET TEMPORARY SHARED USE PATH

The City will be converting the parking lane on the north side of Pawtucket St. from Francis Gate Park to LeLacheur Park to a two-way shared use path for walking and biking, funded as part of a Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) Shared Streets grant. **Installation will occur between Tuesday, October 13 and Friday, October 16.** Parking will not be permitted during and following installation on the north side of the street. All existing parking spaces will remain available on the opposite side of the street. Funeral processions may continue to use Pawtucket Street as needed.

The MassDOT Shared Streets program enables communities to increase the space for walking and biking in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The City will use temporary materials to test the design of this shared use path. The shared use path will remain in place at least until the first major snowstorm.
