



City of Lowell INJURED EMPLOYEES POLICY

In conformity with the written recommendations of the City Physician, I hereby issue this Executive Order to all City Departments:

Effective July 1, 1997, any employee of the City of Lowell who is injured on duty, including all employees of the School Department, Fire Department, Police Department, as well as all other City Departments should be first treated at the following health facility:

Occupational Medicine Department
9 Loon Hill Road
Dracut, MA 01826**

The policy reflected in this Order does not mean that an employee cannot be treated by their own physician, but its intention is rather that the first physician to see an injured employee should be at the Occupational Medicine Department at Lowell General Hospital.

Since several of the City Departments are twenty four (24) hour operations, if an injury occurs during the hours when the Occupational Health Department at Lowell General Hospital is not open, an injured employee should be first treated during off-hours at the Emergency Room at Lowell General Hospital, East Campus, Hospital Drive, Lowell, MA.

If an injury were to occur while an employee was out of the City performing job-related duties and the injury requires immediate treatment, said employee should be treated at the nearest emergency medical facility.

This order does not change the requirement of completing and filing the usual "Injury Report" forthwith.
